UNIVERSE & ADMINISTRATION

In this first QPLIX workshop you will get an overview of the basic concepts, system sections and their interrelationships. You will become familiar with QPLIX parlance and learn how to (manually) set up securities and legal entities/clients as well as maintain and enhance corresponding master data.

LIQUID & ILLIQUID ASSETS

In the workshop on liquid & illiquid assets, we run through the entire cycle of different asset classes in the QPLIX system – from investment, including price supply and master data maintenance, to ad-hoc evaluations and presentation in reports and the portal.

AFTER THIS WORKSHOP

- you will be able to (manually) create stocks, bonds, real estate, and private equity funds (including master data) in QPLIX.
- you will have an understanding of how data and market updates are supplied in QPLIX.
- you will be familiar with the unique characteristics of real estate and closed-end funds in QPLIX.
- you will be able to (manually) record basic transactions for these assets.
- you will know how to analyze these asset classes on an ad-hoc basis and in reports.
